We will be painting memory boxes with Nancy Nicastro after the meeting on June 15. She will demonstrate two really fast designs with templates.

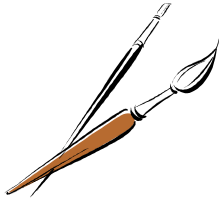
There will be 18 small rectangular boxes available that are base coated white. If you want to bring one of your own that is a different size or shape, please feel free.

If you have shade colors to go with the paint you bring that would be great. Otherwise, Nancy will be bringing some shade colors that will work with one of her designs.



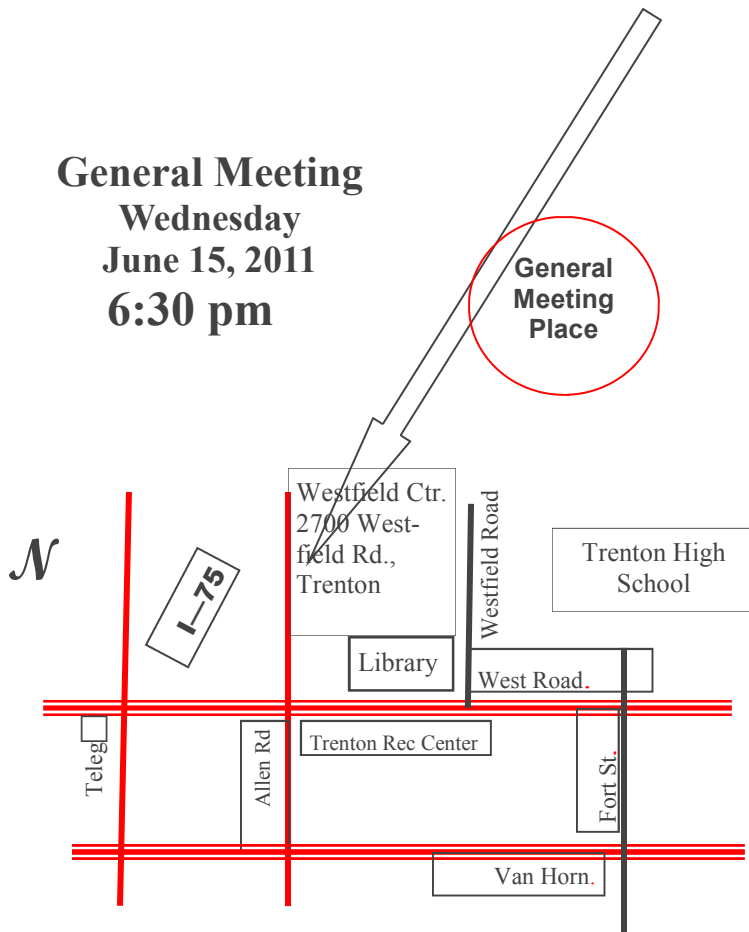
