Fellow Painters....now that the warmer month's are upon us and life is whizzing by, we are in full swing with our preparations for the remainder of the year's activities.

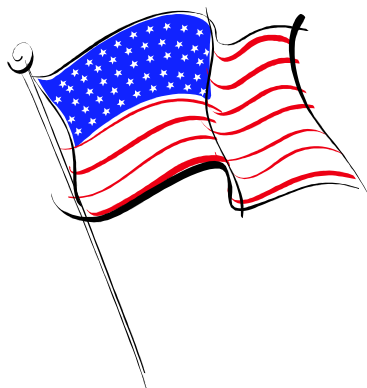
Thank you to Peggy Mack and Prudy Vannier for a very successful seminar. Many members finished early and had a completed project!!! I heard rave reviews about the project.

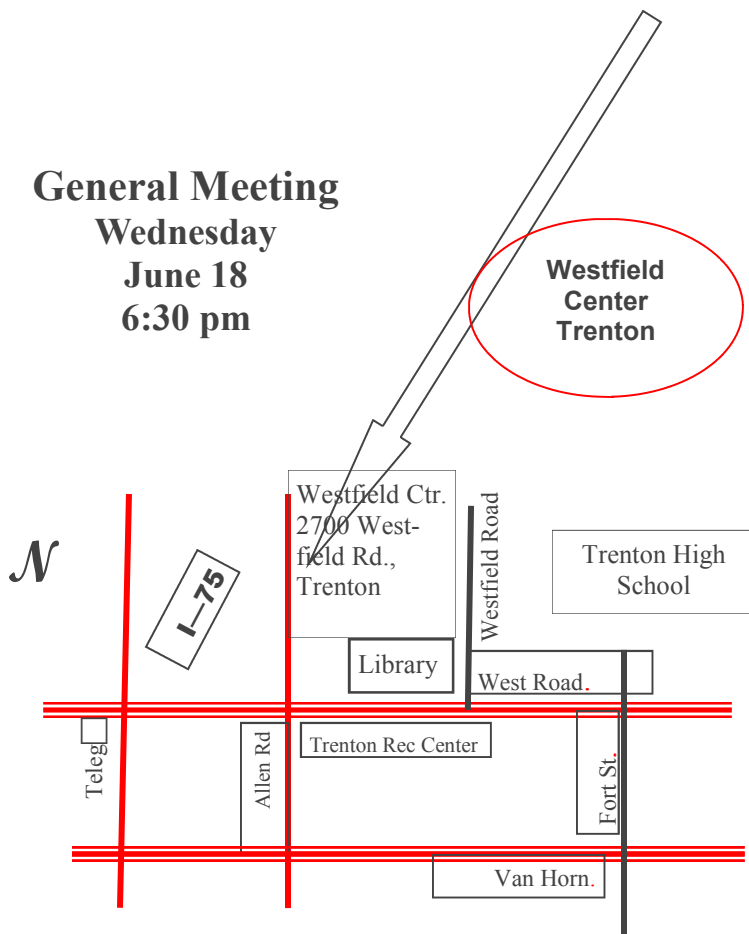
SNAP CHARITY BASKET
